Credit Report:

Notwithstanding anything in this agreement to the contract, financing is available to students without the requirement of one or more co-signors (as Pure Aesthetics, LLC shall determine in its sole discretion) who shall have a credit score of at least 650 points. Students desiring financing must deliver to Pure Aesthetics, LLC a copy of his or her current credit report showing his or her credit score. For qualified students, there are 2 financing term options: 12 or 24 months. If the student's credit score is between 650 and 729 points, he or she could finance the tuition balance at 16% interest per annum (based on a 360 day year) for a 12 month loan term or 18% per annum (based on a 360 day year) for a 24 month loan term. If the student's credit score is 730 points or higher, he or she could finance the tuition balance at 12% per annum (based on a 360 day year) for a 12 month loan and 14% per annum (based on a 360 day year) for a 24 month loan term.

**Students are required to receive one professional facial before graduation. The cost will range between \$20 and \$100, and is not included in the total program costs.

Additional costs include:

Missed hours exceeding 32 hours accumulate and will be charged to the student at a rate of \$13.50 per hour.

Upon completion of the program, exam costs and licensing fees will be incurred to work in Arizona, approximately \$185.00.

The applicant may cancel this contract and receive a full refund (except registration fee) of all monies paid to date if cancellation is made in writing and mailed/delivered to the institution at the address stated herein within three (3) business days after the date of signature or start of the program (which ever one is applicable) minus the cost of any used portion of the kit.

If the student fails to meet financial obligations with Pure Aesthetics, LLC she/he may be suspended from school until the financial obligation is met or other arrangements are made.

Attendance policy will still apply. Student must make arrangements acceptable to the instructor or complete their course of study and make up course work missed.

All financial obligations must be met before reentry into the program or before certificates can be awarded. Late payments are subject to a late fee of 5% of the delinquent sum owed after a five day grace period and are subject to default interest at the rate of 1.5% per month (compounded)

on the total amount owed after a five day grace period and continuing until payment in full. Although the default interest will begin to accrue on the fifth day after the due date, a ten day grace period will be allowed before suspension. Installment payments are expected at the scheduled due date.

Tuition Refund Policy

This policy applies to all terminations, for any reason, by either party. Percentage of program completion will be based on the number of elapsed course hours. The termination date is the last date of actual attendance by the student. Students will be automatically dismissed if they are absent in all consecutive classes over a continuous two week period unless they have prior approval.

- A. The registration fee is not refundable.
- B. An applicant rejected by the school is entitled to a refund of all monies paid minus the registration fee.
- C. All monies paid by the applicant are refunded if requested in writing to Pure Aesthetics, LLC within three business days after signing an enrollment agreement and making an initial payment minus the cost of unreturned or used portion of the kit.
- D. An applicant requesting cancellation more than three days after signing an enrollment contract and making an initial payment, but prior to entering the school is entitled to a refund of all monies paid minus the registration fee of \$200.00 unless otherwise required by law.
- E. Students withdrawing after beginning a program and prior to completing 50% of the scheduled period of enrollment will be refunded based on the tuition and fees assessed to the student on a pro-rated basis.

The scheduled period of enrollment is defined as the entire program.

The refund will be based on the period of enrollment that has elapsed through the last day of attendance by the student. This is determined by the number of clock hours the student has been scheduled to attend through the last recorded date of attendance. These hours are divided by the total program hours to determine percentage of the program elapsed. This percentage will be rounded up to the nearest 10% and multiplied times the total program tuition. A \$100.00 administration fee will also be added to the final total. The sum of these two calculations will then be compared to the amount of tuition paid by the student to determine whether a refund is due or additional tuition is owed.

- F. For a student terminating training after completing more than 50% of the scheduled period of enrollment, the school will retain the entire contract price of the program. No administrative fee will be charged.

G. Special Cases. In case of prolonged illness or accident, death in the family, or other circumstances that make it impractical to complete the program, the school shall make a settlement which is reasonable and fair to both parties.

H. Any monies due to the applicant will be refunded within forty-five days from cancellation or failure to appear on or before the first day of class. Any monies due to the student shall be refunded within forty-five days from the last date of student attendance.

I. If the student does not return from an authorized leave of absence period, refunds will be made within thirty calendar days from the end of the leave of absence.

J. In the event Pure Aesthetics, LLC cancels a program due to insufficient enrollment, all tuition paid will be refunded to the enrolled student within 30 days following the scheduled start date. If for any reason Pure Aesthetics, LLC is permanently shut down after students have begun the course, refunds will be issued based on the amount of course time completed.

K. If a class is postponed more than 60 days from original scheduled start date and the student no longer wishes to continue enrollment, the student may receive a full refund of any registration fees in addition to all tuition. Classes are subject to postponement if less than five students are registered and confirmed at least one week prior to the scheduled class start date

Cancellation or Termination by a Student

If the student desires to cancel this contract they must do so by submitting to Pure Aesthetics, LLC a written statement which includes their date of withdrawal. This date must be on or subsequent to the last date of actual attendance by the student.

Termination by the School

Grounds for termination by the school prior to completion include, without limitation failure to meet program requirements, failure to comply with the rules and regulations established by Pure Aesthetics, LLC, poor attendance, failure to meet financial obligations to the school or failure to uphold the ethics and standards of the aesthetics profession and/or exhibiting behaviors considered inappropriate as determined by Pure Aesthetics, LLC.

Course of Instruction

Pure Aesthetics, LLC agrees to use its best, professional efforts to provide competent instruction in the program offered by the school and the student agrees to make a sustained, diligent effort to study and learn the skills being taught. The student has satisfied herself/himself that the course of instruction is one that meets their needs and requirements in this field of study and is reasonably calculated to produce a graduate who is capable and qualified to engage in the practice of aesthetics. While Pure Aesthetics, LLC the school will use reasonable efforts to provide such a course of instruction, the school cannot guarantee that the student will, in fact, become a skilled aesthetician and the student assumes that risk. The student hereby relieves and holds harmless

Pure Aesthetics, LLC and its manager, members and employees of any liability arising from the action or inaction, fault or neglect of Pure Aesthetics, LLC concerning the instruction provided. The instruction to be provided by the staff and faculty of Pure Aesthetics, LLC shall be substantially similar to that set forth in the catalog which the student acknowledges having received and read. While Pure Aesthetics, LLC will make every effort to follow that course of instruction, other courses and teachers may be substituted. Similar modifications and alterations may be made which, in the judgement of Pure Aesthetics, LLC administration will be best designed to attain the goals of the school and its instructional program.

Upon completion of the course of study prescribed by Pure Aesthetics, LLC, a graduation diploma will be granted, provided the student has successfully passed examinations and satisfied academic, financial and other obligations Pure Aesthetics, LLC. The student understands that employment upon graduation is not guaranteed by Pure Aesthetics, LLC.

Other Terms

The student shall hold harmless and indemnify Pure Aesthetics, LLC for any injuries she/he receives while on the premises of the school not caused by the gross negligence of Pure Aesthetics, LLC.

The terms of this Enrollment Contract supersede any conflicting term in the Pure Aesthetics Catalog.

The Pure Aesthetics Catalog and the Codes, Policies and Rules referred to or set forth therein are made a part of this Enrollment Contract and are incorporated by reference.

This contract shall be governed by the laws of the State of Arizona as that is where Pure Aesthetics, LLC is located and where the contract will be performed, and any legal action brought by either party to enforce it shall be brought in the state court located in Pima County, Arizona, unless all parties agree otherwise.

In the event that any legal action is commenced to enforce any part of this contract or to determine the rights, duties or liabilities of either party, the party that prevails shall be entitled to recover attorney's fees, expenses and cost of suit. Prior to commencing any action in a court of law, both parties agree to use reasonable effort to resolve any dispute they may have, but this provision shall not be a bar to the taking of any such legal action if any party believes that is the appropriate course of action to take.

Any modification or amendment of the terms and conditions of this contract shall be in writing signed by both parties. If some portion of this contract is found to be invalid by a court of law, the remainder of the contract shall continue in full force and effect and continue in the absence of the invalid provision.

As stated in the General Provisions R4-10-112 *Infection Control and Safety Standards*

1. A licensee or student who has a contagious disease of a nature that may be transmitted shall not perform services on an individual until the licensee or student takes medically approved measures to prevent transmission of the disease and (2) services shall not be performed on an individual who has a contagious disease that may be transmitted by the performing of the services on the individual.

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have received and read a copy of this contract and that I understand and agree to its terms and conditions. I recognize that it is not binding until accepted in writing by Pure Aesthetics, LLC.

I also acknowledge that this contract will be void if (1) I do not respond to the request for class registration by the date stipulated in the letter which will accompany the class registration packet or (2) do not show up on the first day of class.

I also certify that I have received and read the Pure Aesthetics, LLC Catalog and fully understand the codes, policies, and rules contained therein. Furthermore, I agree to abide by these codes, policies, and rules and understand that they are an integral part of this legal and binding contract once completed and signed by both parties.

I understand that Pure Aesthetics, LLC can and will impose disciplinary sanctions if I violate any of the standards referred to in the Pure Aesthetics, LLC Catalog.
